The Eco-Schools Committee made up of a mixed group of	1
pupils and adults. The Committee meets at least twice a year. Notes are kept on each meeting. School is kept informed about the Committee's discussion	s
and actions. Environmental Review	
A formal or informal environmental review of the school is	
carried out by the members of the committee. The results of the review are discussed by the Committee.	
Following the review, activities are planned to improve the school's environmental performance.	

Action Plan
 The Committee decides on some action for the school, based on the environmental review. The Committee agrees about who will take the responsibility for specific actions.
Monitoring & Evaluation
 The Committee records progress on the action taken. The Committee discusses the success or otherwise of the action being undertaken.
Curriculum Work
Environmental issues are covered as part of curriculum work in most year groups across a range of subjects.
Informing & Involving
 The Committee has a school notice board that gives details about the environmental activities being carried out. Parent know about the action being undertaken by the school.
The wider school community learns about the environmental activity going on in the school.
Eco Code
There is an agreement on some environmental statements for the school drawn up by the Committee.
